Reflection on the Gospel

Jesus rose "very early before dawn" and went out to a "deserted place" to pray, to be in communion with God. He is able to turn his back on the adulation and keep his mission on a steady course because he does not lose

sight of why he came—to preach the good news of salvation. He does not lose sight of his mission because he never loses sight of his Father. This is how we reorder ourselves—by praying, being in communion with God so that Jesus' mission is truly our own.

There is a balance in the activity of Jesus.

There is prayer: liturgical prayer in the synagogue and that is balanced by private prayer. There is hard work, and that is balanced by rest and relaxation with his apostles. We, as Christians, must have that same balance in our lives. If we blend prayer, work and family or community life properly, then we will be balanced and effective Christians.

Reflexión sobre el Evangelio

Jesús se levantó temprano, "mucho antes de la madrugada" y fue a un "lugar desierto" a orar, para estar en comunión con Dios. Está dispuesto a darle la espalda a la adulación y mantener su misión en rumbo fijo porque no quita Su vista en la razón de porqué vino - a predicar

las Buenas Nuevas de salvación. No pierde vista de Su misión porque nunca pierde vista de Su Padre. Esta es la manera en que nosotros nos organizamos de nuevo — con oración, estando en comunión con Dios — para que la misión de Jesús verdaderamente sea la nuestra.

Hay un balance en la actividad de Jesús. Hay oración: oración litúrgica en la sinagoga, y eso está balanceado por oración privada. Hay trabajo duro, y eso está balanceado con descanso y relajación con los Apóstoles.

Nosotros, como cristianos, debemos tener ese mismo balance en nuestras vidas. Si combinamos oración, trabajo y vida en la familia o comunidad apropiadamente, entonces seremos cristianos balanceados y efectivos.

In today's first Reading from the Book of Job, Job begins to lose hope when the trials begin. In the second reading, Paul continues pushing on, as does Jesus, who cures the sick and those possessed by demons, even though the day is over and the sun has set. We cannot permit the young people who have applied themselves, work diligently and desire to contribute to our society and economy to be rejected brutally and sent back to their countries of origin, where perhaps they do not know the culture or the language.

Now it is estimated that approximately 800,000 young people qualify as DREAMERS. It is estimated that 91% are employed. If they are deported, the economy will lose 700,000 employees. Those who work pay taxes and contribute to the economic growth of our nation.
